

The Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton



By-Law 2024-079

Being a By-Law to Amend By-Law 2020-052, Being the By-Law to Regulate and Control Traffic and Parking Within The Municipality of Brockton.

Whereas the provisions of the *Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H.8*, as amended, and the *Municipal Act, R.S.O. 2001, S.O. 2001*, as amended, authorize Municipal Councils to pass by-laws to regulate and control traffic.

And Whereas the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton passed By-Law 2020-052 to regulate and control traffic within the Municipality of Brockton on April 28, 2020.

And Whereas the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton desires to amend its existing Traffic and Parking By-Law 2020-052.

Now Therefore the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton enacts as follows:

1. That Schedule “A” to By-Law 2020-052, being the schedule for “Stop Signs”, be amended to include the following street and intersection where a stop sign shall be erected;

Eastridge Road	Eastridge Road	Heading East at the intersection of Eastridge Road

2. That a Schedule “L” be added to By-Law 2020-052 to implement 40 km/hr zones in the following locations within the East Ridge Business Park in Walkerton;

Column 1 Street	Column 2 From	Column 3 To	Column 4 Time
Eastridge Road	County Road 19	Cunningham Road	At all times
Ontario Road	County Road 4	Creighton Road	At all times
Creighton Road	County Road 19	Zettler Road	At all times
Zettler Road	Eastridge Road	Creighton Road	At all times
Old Durham Road	Elm Street	Ontario Road	At all times

3. That By-Law 2020-052 by hereby amended.
4. This By-Law shall come into full force and effect upon final passage.
5. This By-Law may be cited as the “Amend Traffic and Parking By-Law (ERBP)”.
