2024 Budget Meetings

The Council of the Municipality of Brockton held Special Council Meetings to consider the 2024 Municipal Budget on January 16, 2024 and February 6, 2024. The video recordings of these Council Meetings are available to view through clicking on the meeting dates on our website calendar, or on the Budget Consultation 2024 project on Build Your Brockton. An additional Special Council Meeting is being held at 6:00 p.m. on February 20, 2024 prior

to the regular Council Meeting at the Bruce County Council Chambers (30 Park St, Walkerton) to finalize the 2024 Municipal budget.

Tax Installment Due Dates – March 29, 2024 and May 31, 2024

Any payment received in our office after the due date will be considered late and any outstanding taxes will be subject to penalty and interest charges as per the Municipal Act, 2001. Please allow 2 to 3 days for processing if you are paying through the online banking system of your financial institution. Visit Brockton.ca/Taxes for more information.

Payment Options

You may use the following payment options to pay all municipal bills and invoices:

- In person at the Municipal Office via Debit, Cash, Cheque, or Post Dated Cheque
- Online/Telephone Banking Allow 2 to 3 days for processing and ensure your account information is updated
- Credit/Debit Card pay using credit or debit card through Paymentus at Brockton.ca/Payments or on the mobile app, a 2.5% service charge fee applies

Address Changes

Please notify the tax department if you have any changes to your mailing address. Address Change Requests must be done in writing or by email to taxes@brockton.ca. Your cooperation in keeping your tax records up to date ensures timely receipt of your tax and utility bills from our office.

Animal Control – Dog Tags

The Municipality of Brockton mailed dog tag invoices in January 2024. Invoices are based on dog owner information in our current database, and your dog will continue to wear the permanent tag you received previously. If you no longer own a dog, need a replacement tag or to register a new dog, please contact the By-Law Department by phone at 519-881-2223 Ext. 141, or email the Animal Control/By-Law Enforcement Officer.

2024 Dog Tag Fees

• First Dog - \$20.00

- Additional Dog(s) \$20.00
- Late Fee (after April 1st) \$10.00/per tag
- Dangerous Dog(s) \$200.00/per dog
- Replacement Dog Tag \$5.00
- Kennel Licence New or Renewal (Includes first inspection fee) *More than 3 dogs and must meet Kennel Licence requirements - \$150.00
- Kennel Licence Non-Compliance re-inspection of Kennel -\$50.00/per inspection
- Kennel Licence Late Payment Charge (after April 1st) -\$60.00
- Recovery of Dog(s) from the Vet Clinic (Municipal Free) + Cost Incurred for Kennel Service - \$100.00

Kennels - If you are registering a new kennel or renewing a kennel license, a Kennel Application and inspection is required. Kennel Applications can be found on the Municipal website or by contacting the Building/By-Law Department at 519-881-2223 ext 141 or email the Animal Control/By-Law Enforcement Officer.

Winter Parking Restrictions

In accordance with Section 8 of the Municipality of Brockton's Consolidated Traffic and Parking By-Law 2020-052, no person shall park on any highway between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. inclusive during the months of November, December, January, February, March and April. A reminder that it is illegal to deposit snow on sidewalks or roads.

Winter Landfill Hours

From November 1 to March 31, the Brant Landfill is open on Wednesdays from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and Saturdays from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. The Greenock Landfill is open on Saturdays from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. The Walkerton/Hanover Landfill is open on Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays, and Saturdays from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. All residents are encouraged to continue to use curbside pickup services.
