Alternating Lane Closures on Durham Street Bridge in Walkerton

Bridge rehabilitation repairs are taking place from Spring 2024 to Fall 2024 at the Durham Street Bridge in Walkerton, Ontario. Motorists can expect lane closures on the bridge, with traffic control measures in place which started the week of May 27, 2024 and will end in December 2024. Signage is in place during these lane closures. Users are asked to be patient and drive safely as the Contractor works to complete crucial repairs to the bridge. Thank you for your

Campfire Safety

The Walkerton Fire Department would like to remind residents to be safe when having campfires (also known as recreational fires). Recreational fires burn within an area that is no larger than 0.6 meters (24 inches) in diameter and height of 0.3 (12 inches) meters, provided such fire is used for warmth or cooking food.

In accordance with the Municipality of Brockton's Open Air Burn By-Law 2017-034, recreational fires are not allowed to be set or allowed to burn where said fire is less than 10 meters from any

building, structure, hedge, tree, fence, highway or vehicular right of way, overhead wire or combustible material of any

Ensure that fires are never left unattended and that you have a way to extinguish them readily available just in case. It is always a good idea to check to make sure that fires are allowed to be lit especially during extremely dry periods.
