## THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROCKTON BY-LAW #2005-23

BEING A BY-LAW TO RESTRICT THE USE OF THE MUNICIPAL WATER SUPPLY BY LIMITING THE TIMES PERMITTED TO WATER GARDENS OR LAWNS

**WHEREAS** the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001 Section 11, as amended, authorizes the passing of a by-law for regulating water distribution;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton is desirous of passing a by-law for regulating the times permitted to water gardens or lawns:

**NOW THEREFORE** be it enacted by the Council of the Municipality of Brockton hereby **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS**:

- 1. No person shall use the municipal water supply for the purpose of watering gardens or lawns except in accordance with the times permitted as follows:
  - Municipal or civic addresses with even numbers shall be permitted to water on even numbered days, but only during the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., both local time
  - municipal or civic addresses with odd numbers shall be permitted to water on odd numbered days, but only during the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., both local time
  - municipal or civic addresses that have automatic watering systems shall be permitted to water on any day, but only during the hours of 2:30 a.m. to 6:00 a.m., local time
- 2. By-Law #2003-35 is hereby repealed.
- 3. Every person who contravenes any provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence and is subject to the penalties under the Provincial Offences Act.
- 4. This by-law shall come into force and effect upon the final passing thereof.
