Brockton Clerk Announces 2022 Official Municipal and School Board Election Results

Brockton, ON, October 25, 2022 – In the 2022 Brockton Municipal and School Board Election, 2,839 eligible voters cast their ballot for Municipal Councillor and School Board Trustee candidates for the 2022-2026 term. The Mayor and Deputy Mayor positions were both acclaimed. At 8:50 p.m. the Director of Legislative and Legal Services (Clerk) announced the results of the Brockton 2022 Municipal and School Board Election.

Brockton saw voter turnout of 35.4% with 2,839 voters, out of the 8,012 eligible electors, casting their ballot by internet or telephone. The Municipality continued to make voting accessible for all residents by offering internet and telephone voting, as well as Voting Help Centres at the Municipal Office in Walkerton, Cargill Community Centre, and Elmwood Community Centre. The Municipality has offered internet and telephone voting since 2014. In 2018, the voter turnout was 49.03%.
