Low	<p>Installation of Fire extinguishers Regular maintenance routine including checking wire, signs of corrosion and clearing dust/cobwebs Develop and implement a fire safety plan for your facilities Develop and practise an evacuation plan for your facilities(human and livestock) Enforce a strict "no smoking" policy in and around your structures Training of family and staff on safe use of equipment, hot work etc. that may be done.</p>
